SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

All submittals must be accompanied by the applicable permit application fee.

All submittals must include the name, telephone and address of the owner and contractor when different from the applicant. A written consent to the application by the owner must be submitted when the owner is different from the applicant.

All submittals, must include 2 copies of a scaled or fully dimensioned, legible, certified survey (minimum size 8 ½ " by 14" and maximum size of 11" by 17") depicting the property to be served and reflecting the proposed use and elevation views, and relationship to the works of the District tied to a known reference point in the immediate area of the proposed use.

In addition, 2 sets of the following information will be required to accompany the submittals for each of the following types of permit application:

1. IRRIGATION

- a. Site plan must include pump location, service line size and location, and the point of connection to District works.
- b. Pump specifications.
- c. Proposed water demand.
- d. Legal description with proof of ownership of the property served.

2. DRIVEWAY

- a. Site plan must include the driveway location and proposed material, and the point of crossing of District works.
- b. Legal description with proof of ownership of the property served.
- c. District will set pipe elevations for installation of pipes.
- d. **Temporary Driveway Culverts are good for 90 days only, no extensions.**

3. UTILITY CROSSING

- a. Plans and specifications depicting the location and type of utility installation with sufficient detail for the District to determine the exact nature of any impact to District rights-of-way, facilities, or the maintenance thereof.

4. RESIDENTIAL DRAINAGE CONNECTION

- a. Site plan for residential drainage connection must include improvements, elevations from lowest floor, and grading plan for site. Applicants for any other type of drainage connection are required to meet with the Board of Supervisors at their regular monthly meeting prior to a determination of final submittal requirements.
- b. Legal description with proof of ownership of the property served.

5. OTHER USES OR ACTIVITIES

- a. Applicants for permit uses not described above will be required to meet with the Board of Supervisors at their regular monthly meeting prior to a determination of final submittal requirements.
- b. Legal description with proof of ownership of the property served.
