CONSENT AGENDA

AUDIT PRESENTATIONS

CANAL 6 MULCHING

FEMA PROJECT

The contract for the Ballard/Baker/Marlin/Bancroft area construction has been signed. Construction will begin within a few weeks and is estimated to be completed in mid 2010

RISER BARRELS

Mr. Davis reported that the riser barrels on Canal 6 have had a temporary repair made to them.

LANDOWNER COMMENTS

Mary Heeney who lives on Oberly Pkwy. Expressed her concerns of rising water onto her front yard. Mr. Mauck asked the District Engineer to look at this area and report back to the Board with his recommendations.

Mr. Unser expressed his appreciation to the Board and especially Mr. Davis and staff for their participation in the Wedgefield Neighborhood Watch event that was held in the park.

The Board President, on behalf of the entire Board expressed their condolences to the family of Wanda Tucker.
