CONSENT AGENDA

Treasurer's report, Regular Meeting Minutes of February 2, 2011; driveway permits and "other" permits were approved as submitted. The disbursements were authorized.

CANAL 6 PROJECT UPDATE

Mr. Davis reported that pipe work has started on the west end of Canal 6 at structure number 5.

FEMA I PROJECT - REOPENED

Florida Division of Emergency Management notified Mr. Davis of the possibility of additional monies available for the FEMA 1 project that was just completed. Mr. Davis and the District Engineer will meet with FDEM to discuss the requirements for obtaining this money.

FEMA II PROJECT

Mr. Davis and the District Engineer are working with FEMA to obtain up to six million dollars in funding for projects within the District. The Board agreed and directed Legal Council to draft a Resolution stating the District will provide the 25% of their share if awarded the money.

2011 ELECTION POLICY

The Board voted to adopt the 2011 Election Policy as submitted.

REGIONAL OFFSITE MITIGATION AGREEMENT

The Board received a draft of the MOA (Memorandum Of Agreement) between St. Johns River Water Management District, Ranger Drainage District and Orange County. District Engineer anticipates this agreement to be finalized and presented to the Board at the April meeting. This agreement allows the District to have a mitigation bank for any project within the District that need mitigating.
